The Government of Bangladesh (GOB) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Urban Resilience Project-DNCC Part, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Procurement of ICT Equipment for Command and Control Room (CCR) at FSCD, Dhaka.
2. The Urban Resilience Project-DNCC Part, Dhaka North City Corporation now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for Procurement of ICT Equipment for Command and Control Room (CCR) at FSCD, Dhaka. The location of delivery of goods is Dhaka, Bangladesh. The delivery period is nine (9) months from the date of contract. Qualifications requirements of the Bidders include: (i) general experience of manufacturing/supplying of the proposed goods is at least five (5) years; (ii) specific experience for the supply, installation, testing and commissioning of similar goods in command center/ control center/ operation center or similar establishment, systems and services in a single contract of at least USD 2600000.00 (Two Million Six Hundred Thousand US Dollar) or equivalent between January 01, 2013 and the date of submission.; (iii) minimum total amount of available liquid asset and/ or working capital and/ or credit facility USD 2600000.00 (Two Million Six Hundred Thousand US Dollar) or equivalent. A margin of preference for certain goods manufactured domestically shall be applied. More detail qualifications requirements are provided in the bid documents.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
4. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of BDT 7000.00 (Seven Thousand Bangladesh Taka) or US\$ 70.00 (Seventy US Dollar). The method of payment will be cash or pay order.
7. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 02.00 p.m. local time (GMT + 6 hrs.), 22 January 2020. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on 02.45 p.m. local time (GMT + 6 hrs.), 22 January 2020.

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of in favor of the "Project Director, Urban Resilience Project-DNCC part" in the form of an unconditional and irrevocable Bank Guarantee/ Bank Draft/ Pay Order from a reputed bank. The amount and currency of the bid security shall be USD 75000.00 (Seventy Five Thousand US Dollar) or BDT 6400000.00 Million (Sixty Four Lac Bangladesh Taka) or EURO 66000.00 (Sixty Six Thousand EURO).
